

Cost of illness approach






## Diarrhoea



# Water Supply and Age groups







## **Assumptions**

- ■Incidence rate 2.5 episodes
  - ■Wright et al., 2007 7.2 episodes
- ■8% treated if < RDP W & S
- ■5% treated if > RDP w & S
- ■50% of local clinic, GP
- ■70% of hospital cases transport costs, rest walked
